



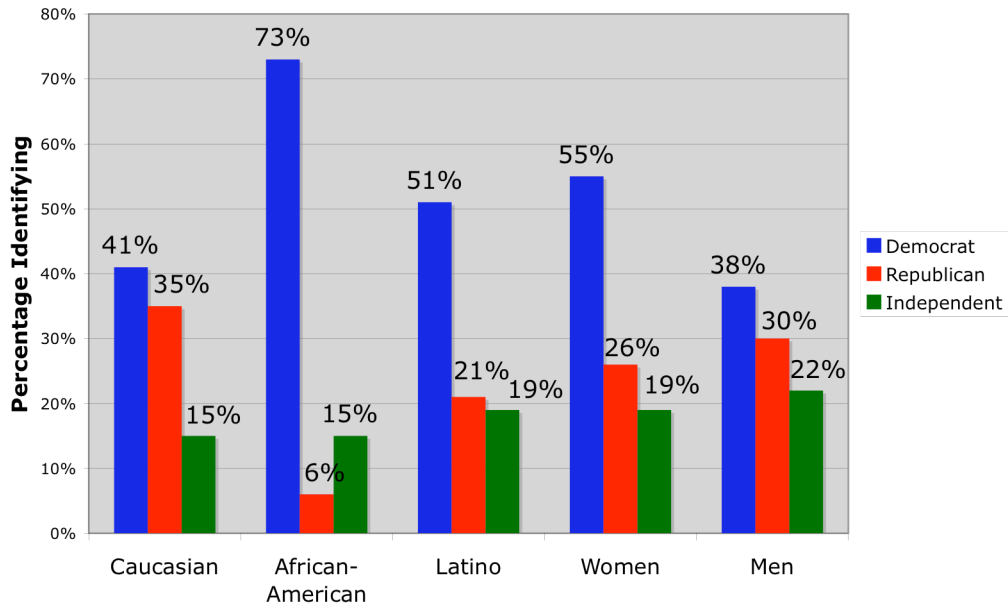
Young Republican Voters

Young Republicans have been voting in record numbers over the course of the last four years. In 2008, young Republican turnout is up in early primary states.

Who Are Young Republicans?

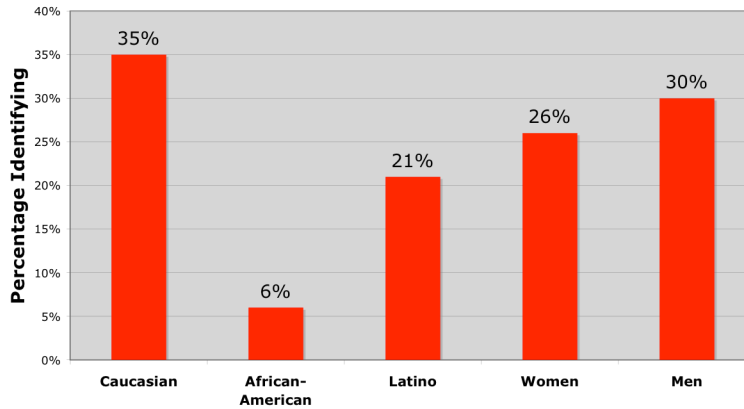
Overall, 28% of 18-29 year olds identify as Republicans. Among young men, 30% identify as Republicans, compared to 26% of young women. Republican identification is also highest among Caucasian youth, with 35% identifying as Republicans.¹

Party ID of 18-29 Year Olds Across Demographic Subsets



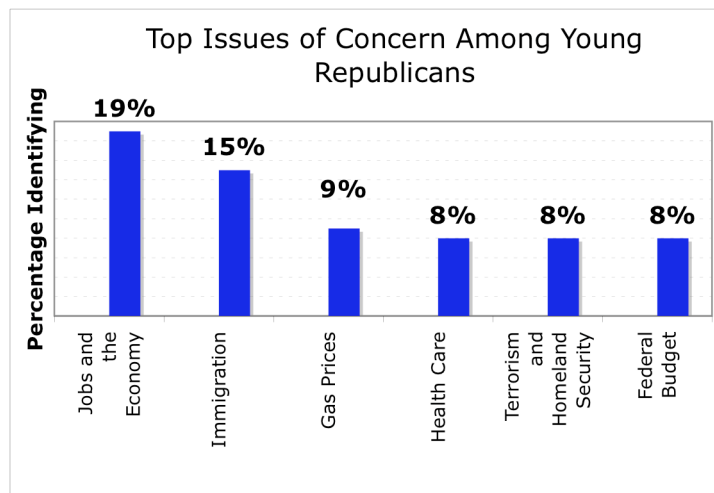

Political Attitudes

Young Republicans say jobs and the economy is their **top issue of concern**, followed immigration, gas prices, health care, terrorism and homeland security, and the federal budget deficit. Young Republicans identified immigration as more important than any other subset of the youth demographic (15% of young Republicans identified it as a top issue, compared with a close second, young Latinos at 14%, and young men at 9%). Terrorism and homeland security, and the federal budget deficit also registered higher among young Republicans, both at 8%, than overall respondents at 5% each.²



Courting young Republicans is a long-term investment that also pays short term dividends. As young Republican turnout continues to rise, they will become an increasingly important part of the Republican electorate.
