

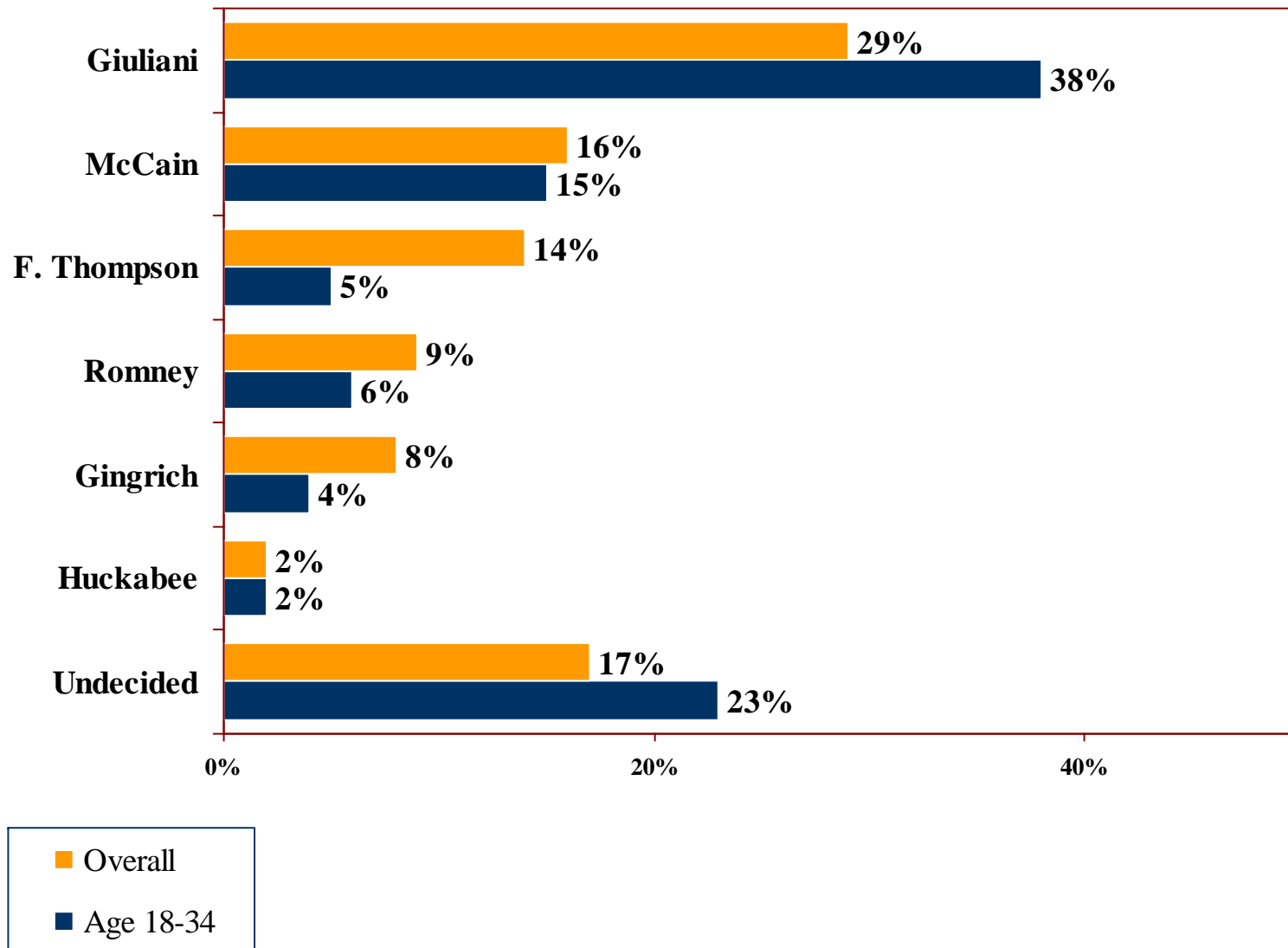

If the Republican primary or caucus for President were held today in your state for whom would you vote if the candidates were...



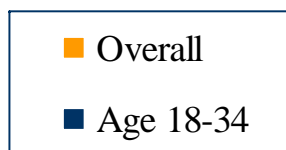
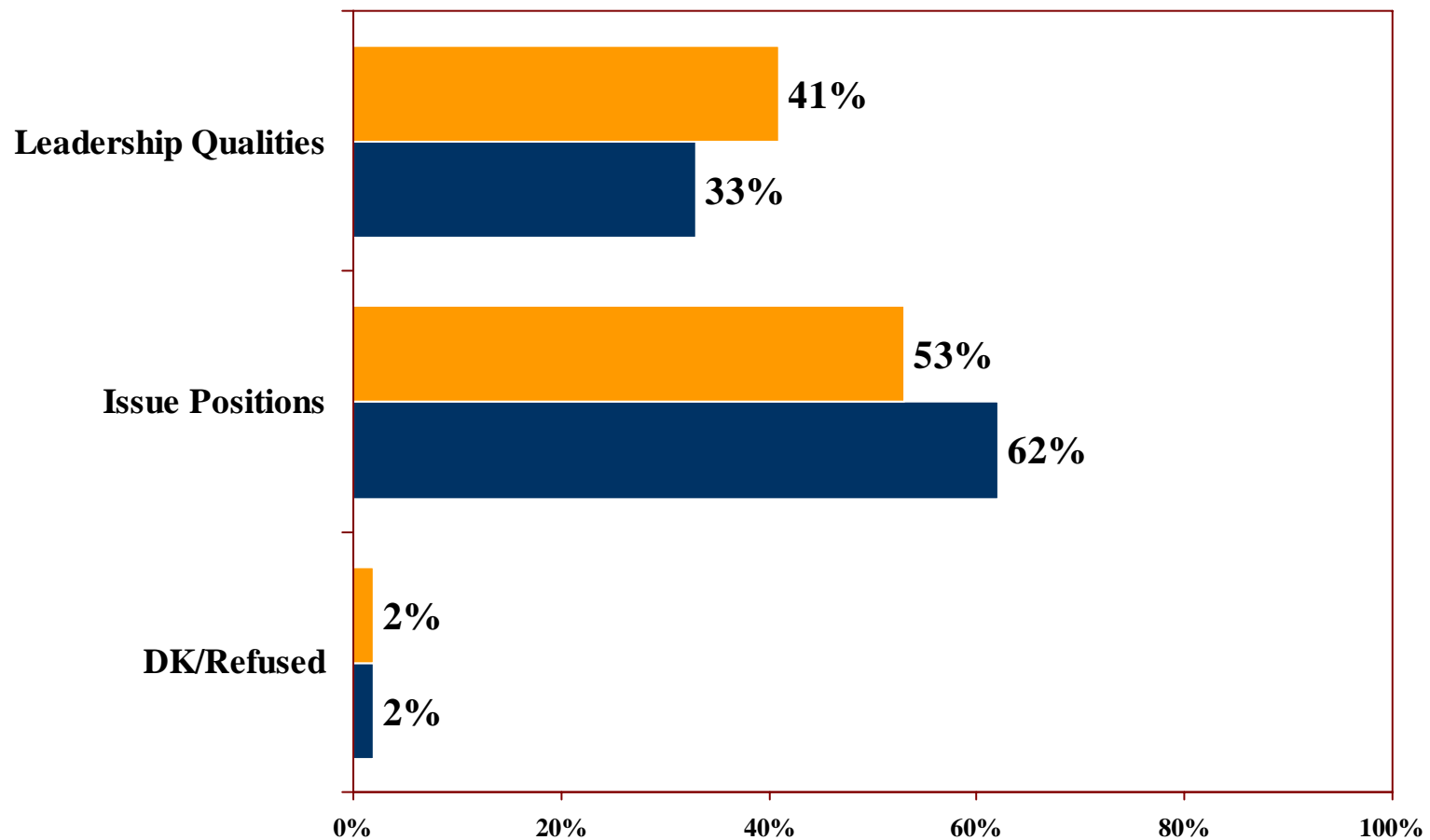

All other things being equal, which is MOST important to you in deciding your vote for President a candidate's leadership qualities or a candidate's position on the issues?



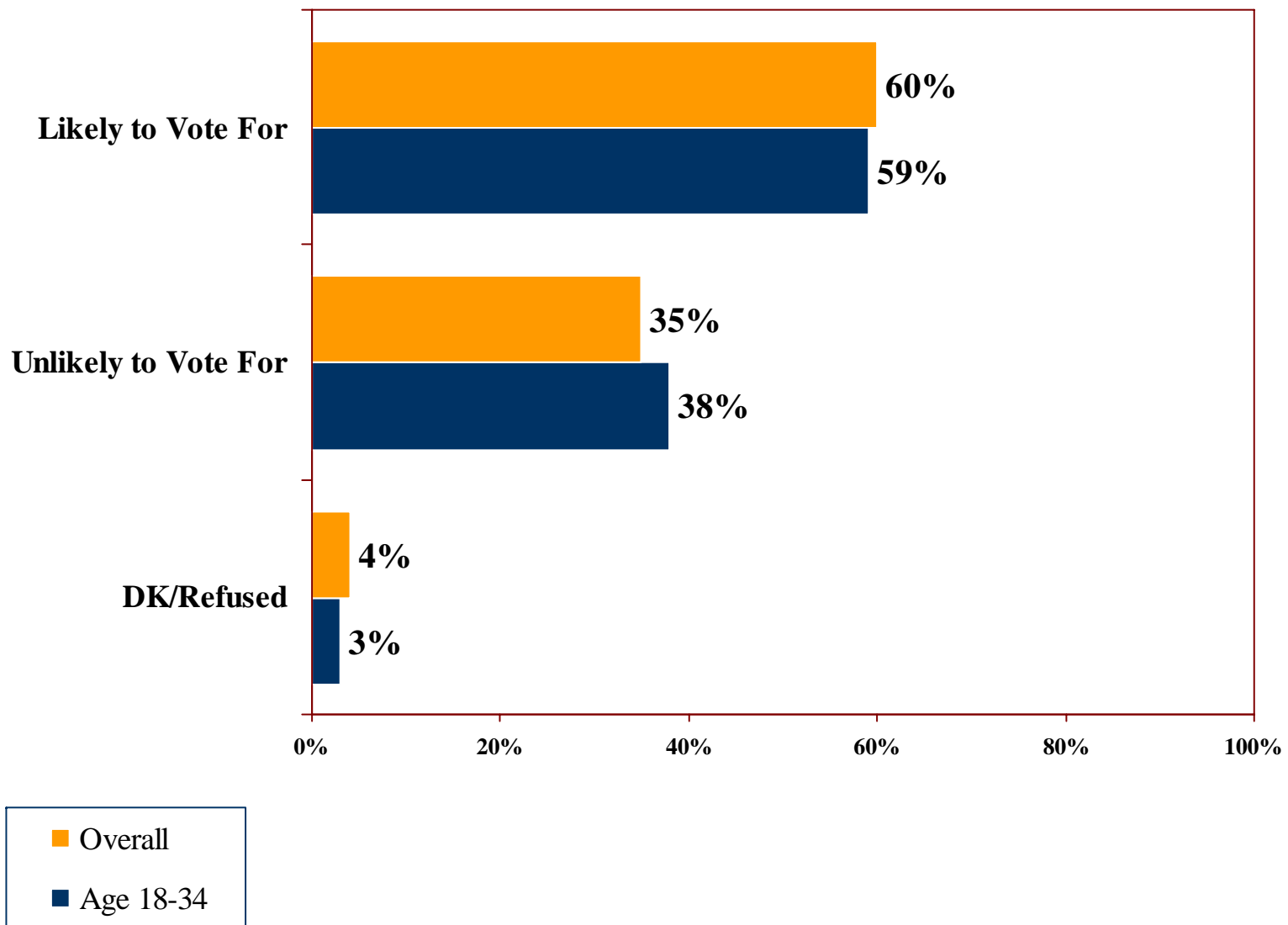

Do you favor or oppose allowing gays and lesbians to openly serve in the U.S. Military?



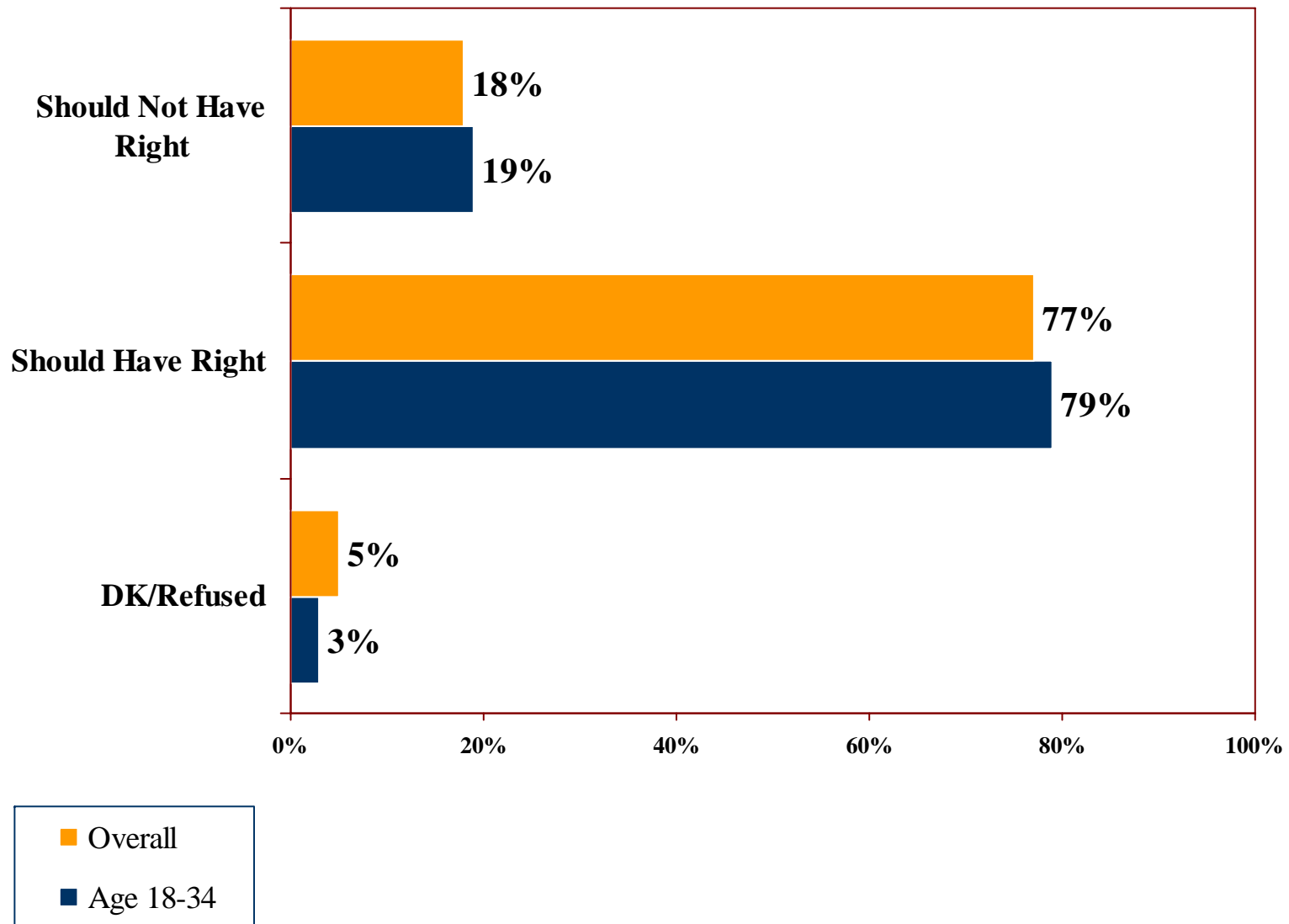

If you had to classify yourself, would you say you are conservative, moderate, or liberal in your political beliefs?



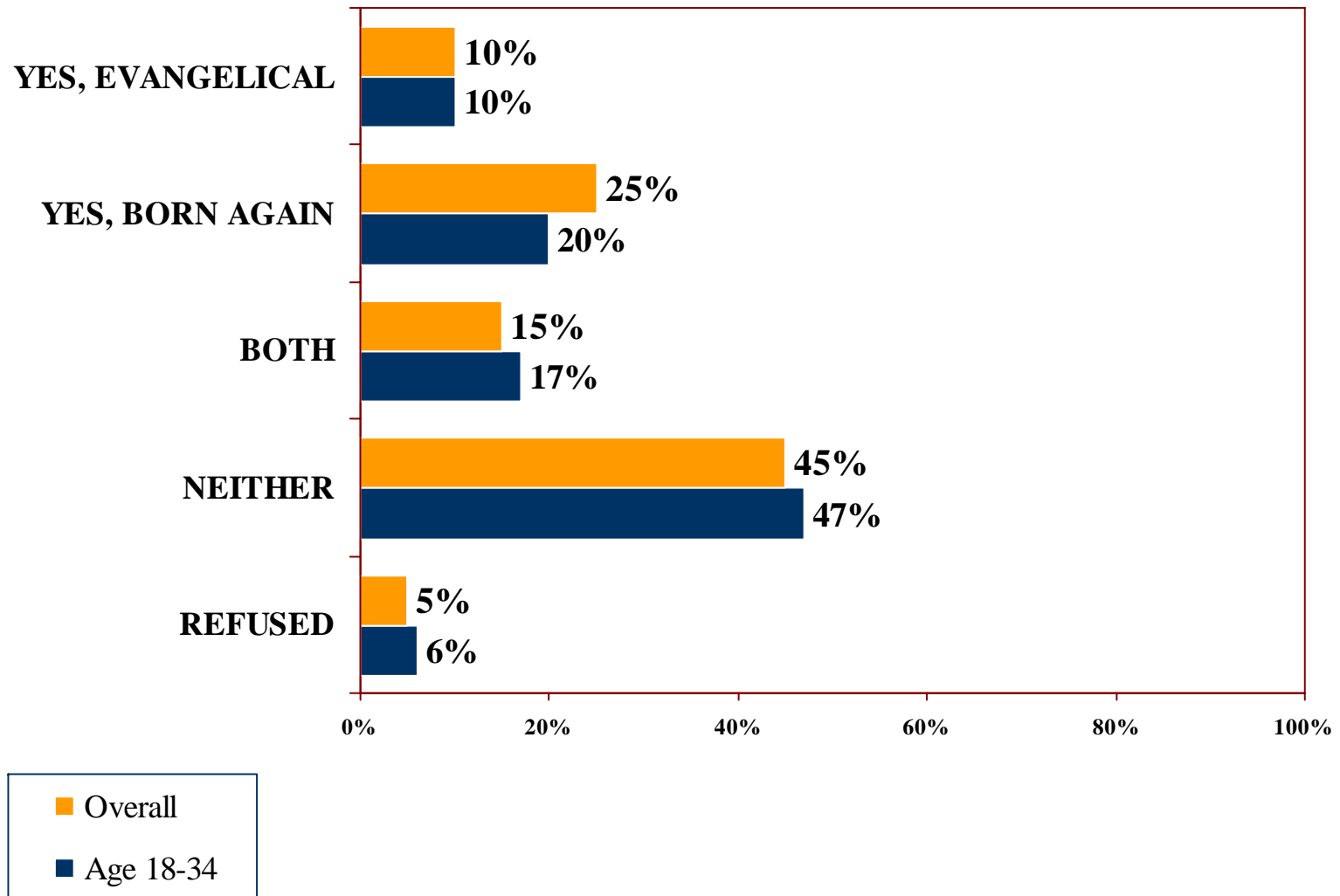

Do you consider yourself a Born-Again or Evangelical Christian?



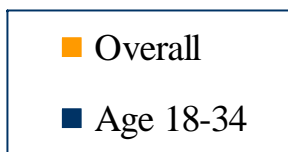
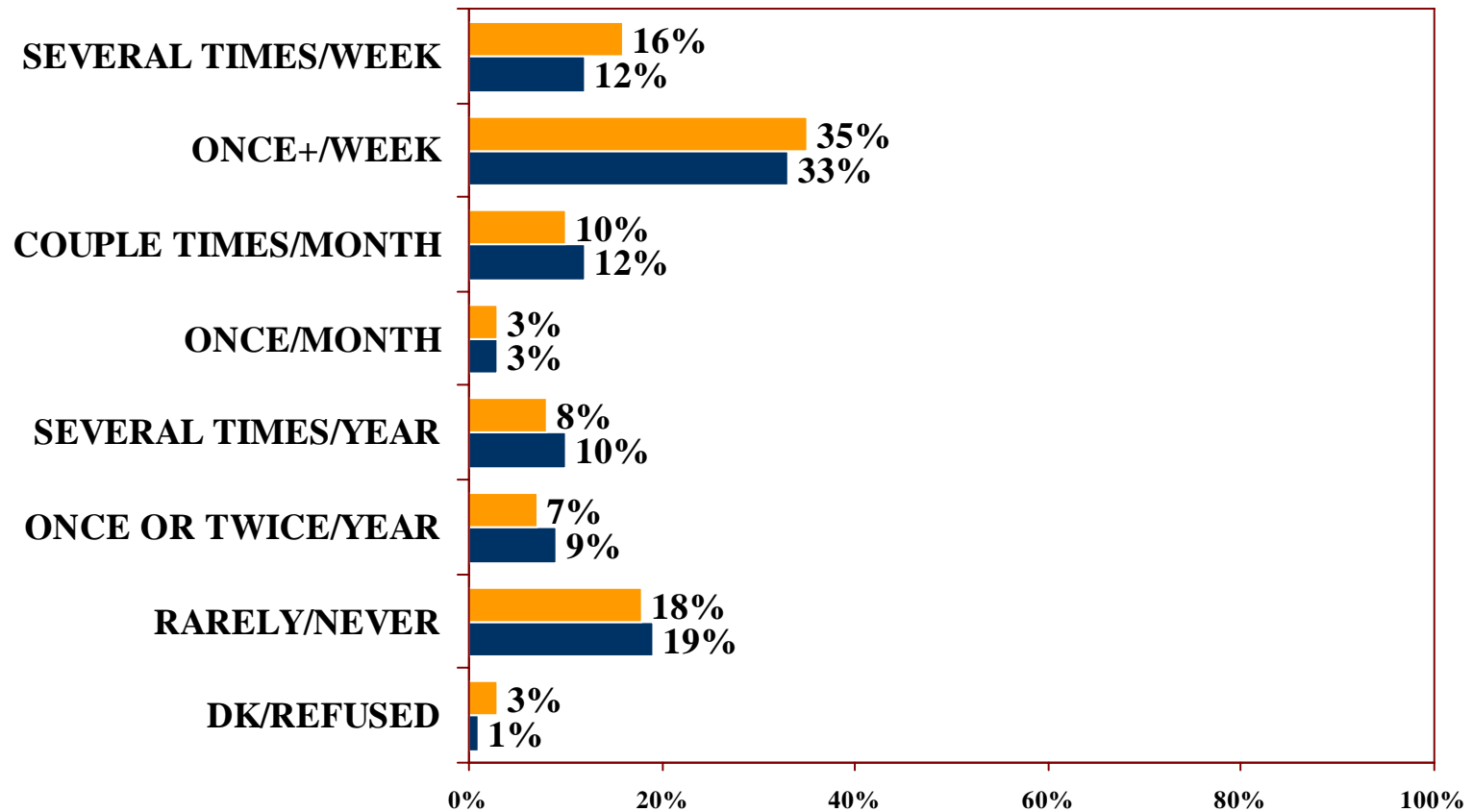
